



## **ST. FRANCIS XAVIER PARISH WEDDING MUSIC GUIDELINES & SUGGESTIONS**

Thank you for choosing St. Francis Xavier Parish to celebrate your Sacrament of Marriage! In choosing music for a wedding mass or wedding ceremony, it is important to remember that as a sacrament – a holy union - all musical choices must emphasize God’s love for you, your love for God, the love of community for you, your love for them and how they support and confirm your love for each other. Thus, the lyrics of songs chosen for the wedding liturgy should express the Christian concept of life, rather than one which is purely secular. The texts must always be in conformity with Catholic doctrine; indeed, they should be drawn chiefly from Holy Scripture, and from liturgical sources.<sup>1</sup> If you do not have any preferences for music, the Director of Music & Liturgy can select the music that would be suitable for the liturgy. ### **MUSICIANS/INSTRUMENTS**

Your wedding fee includes a pianist/organist and a cantor. Outside musicians must be approved by the Director of Music & Liturgy **at least eight weeks before your wedding date**. If using the parish-provided musicians, please indicate your preference on whether you would like the organ or piano (or both) to be played. To inquire about including other musicians in your ceremony, please contact the Director of Music & Liturgy.

### **PRELUDE MUSIC**

Instrumental music may be played while guests are being seated. If desired, a sung piece of music may be used here so long as it conforms to the requirements mentioned in the first paragraph.

### **ENTRANCE RITE**

It is most common to have either (1) one piece of music for the seating of parents (and any optional candle lighting), the procession of the bridal party and the bride; or (2) a first piece of music for the seating of parents (and any optional candle lighting) and the procession of the bridal party, and a second piece of music for the entrance of the bride. *If only one piece of music is chosen to cover the entire Entrance Rite, it can be arranged that there is a musical change at the entrance of the bride.*

## **THE MASS SETTING**

The “Mass setting” consists of the acclamations sung by the congregation that are part of the prescribed prayers of the Mass. *Note: If the ceremony is not a full mass, we will only sing the Gospel Acclamation.*

1. Glory to God (*this can be omitted if desired*)
2. Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia/Praise to You, Lord Jesus Christ
3. Eucharistic Acclamations: Holy, Holy, Holy / We Proclaim Your Death / Amen / Lamb of God
