PROGRAM SPECIFIC TIMES

Edge is for 6th through 8th graders and meets Wednesdays at 6:30 pm.

They meet on Wednesdays from 6:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. You **MUST** sign your child in and out of the Hall or have a designated adult sign them in and out. Hall doors open at 6:30 p.m. for drop off, and at 8:00 for pick up.

NOTE: CHILDREN MUST NOT BE LEFT ALONE OUTSIDE AND SFX PARISH AND VOLUNTEERS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY CHILD LEFT ALONE OUTSIDE.

PLEASE PICK UP YOUR CHILD PROMPTLY AT THE END OF EDGE NIGHTS.

Life Teen is for all High School students in grades 9-12, and meets on Sunday evenings, starting with the 5 pm Mass.

Life Teen starts with the Sunday, 5 p.m. mass and then continues in the Life House. High school students may sign themselves into the Life Night. Please note if you are picking up your child that Life Teen ends at 8 pm. If you are not able to attend the 5 pm Mass, meet us in the Life House at 6:15 p.m.

Formation in our faith is a life-long spiritual journey. Your child's faith formation, like their academic education, should be attended continuously throughout their years of schooling.

If your child needs any sacraments, they will automatically be enrolled in our RCIT program, the sacrament preparation program for those in grades 6-12. Sacrament preparation includes the following:

1. Weekly attendance at Sunday Mass
2. Weekly participation in age-appropriate ministry
 - a. Edge for those in grades 6-8
 - b. Life Teen for those in grades 9-12
3. Monthly participation in Sacrament Preparation, which meets on the second Tuesday of every month, and is for youth AND their parents. Parents must attend with their child(ren).

All children who need sacraments must present a Certificate of Baptism for those who have been baptized. If baptism has not yet occurred, please present a Birth Certificate.
